An ambitious project involving numerous international contemporary artists and disused Military airplanes is set to make it's debut on January 28th at the Pima Art and Space Museum in Tucson, Arizona. *The Boneyard Project: Return Trip* will include artists Andrew Schoultz, How & Nosm, Nunca, Retna, and Faile who will all paint their own individual airplanes, along with cockpit from Saner. The concept for resurrecting the no longer active airplanes was conceived in spring 2010 by Eric Firestone, and organized with curator Carlo Mccormick.
