Mark Moore Gallery is pleased to announce *Summer Pleasures*, a unique exhibition of works by twelve young artists from around the United States (California, New York, Nevada and Texas) and the world (Australia, Austria, Israel, Northern Ireland and Mexico). These artists are pursuing a range of issues in a variety of media, including painting and sculpture, drawing and collage.

Though the work of Tim Bavington, Todd Hebert, David Ryan, Christoph Schmidberger and Yoram Wolberger are well known in Los Angeles through their exhibitions at Mark Moore Gallery and elsewhere, the majority of the non-gallery artists featured in *Summer Pleasures* have never shown in the city. They include José León Cerrillo (Mexico and New York), Holly Coulis (New York), Conor McGrady (Northern Ireland and New York), James Morrison (Australia), Jamie Ruiz Otis (Mexico), Sally-Ann Rowland (New York) and Dan Sutherland (Texas).

The work of Holly Coulis has appeared in solo exhibitions at Zach Feuer Gallery/LFL and elsewhere; Sally-Ann Rowland recently had her second solo show, *I'm So Sorry You Feel That Way*, at ZieherSmith in New York; works by José León Cerrillo and Conor McGrady were featured in this summer's *Greater New York* exhibition at PS1; James Morrison's American debut came as a part of the group exhibition, *Some Forgotten Place* at the UC Berkeley Art Museum last fall; a solo exhibition of the work of Jamie Ruiz Otis is currently on view at the MCA San Diego in that museum's CERCA series; and Dan Sutherland's work was the subject of a recent solo exhibition at the McNay Art Museum in San Antonio.
